Chesapeake Public Schools Experiential Learning Program

In December 2019, The Growth and Opportunity in Virginia (**GO Virginia**), a statewide economic development initiative based in Richmond, Virginia, granted the Loudoun Education Foundation (LEF) a total of \$2.4 million dollar grant to support the Virginia K-12 Computer Science Pipeline initiative. This grant supports the 6-12 portion of the Virginia K-12 Computer Science Pipeline, which funds the creation and implementation of an education model for teaching computer science and computational thinking skills, as well as providing computer science electives in middle school, and an Experiential Learning program in high school. Both Chesapeake Public Schools and Loudoun County Public Schools are involved with securing internships opportunities for their students.

In support of the **GO Virginia** initiative, by 2022, Chesapeake Public Schools will need to create approximately 275 new internships, and develop the computer science curriculum. To that end, we are looking to connect with businesses/companies in the Hampton Roads area, who would like to partner with our team to develop internship opportunities for our students.
