



Open Data is free, publicly available data that can be accessed and used by anyone. It includes government data at every level, scientific and research data, and certain types of commercial data.

Companies around the world have been using Open Data to improve existing lines of business, or to develop entirely new lines of business in segments as diverse as health care, finance, transportation, and legal services. The McKinsey Global Institute has estimated the untapped value of Open Data to exceed \$3 trillion.
